


Oxigen & Sahyog Foundation in the month of May 2018 conducted 4 eye camps in collaboration with various Hospitals and social service organizations. The patients are given the best treatment at the lowest rates and most of the time medicines are provided free of cost. Operations for cataract, glaucoma and retina are done. We fixed 18th June 2018 with the hospital and informed Patients at Village Khohri in district Alwar. 7 underwent cataract surgeries at Lions Eye Hospital on the respective date. Precaution and medicines have been given to these patients and their next follow up is due soon.

The sequence of steps taken to screen, transport, and conduct the surgery are as follows:

- 1) The patients who come to the camp site are registered
- 2) The patients are screened to determine their eyesight problem
- 3) Those found in need of cataract surgery are tested for inter-ocular pressure

- 4) Patients are then screened for high blood pressure and blood sugar
- 5) The patients who do not have any health complications and are deemed to be in need of cataract surgery are subjected to a final screening by the ophthalmologist
- 6) Patients are then transported to the hospital by bus provided by the OXIGEN & SAHYOG Foundation
- 7) The patients are admitted to the hospital and are operated the same day.. During the surgical procedure, clouded lens is removed and a plastic intra-ocular lens is implanted





Oxigen & Sahyog foundation has brought a new ray of hope for the hopeless and helpless people. The patients being operated at hospital acknowledge that with the help & blessings of volunteers rendering selfless services to them more than their own kin they will be able to restore their vision back. The happiness on the faces of patients getting operated in the eye camp can be clearly seen.
