CATARACT EYE SURGERY CAMP REPORT

In its endeavors towards serving the community, Oxigen & Sahyog Foundation organizes free cataract

operation camp for aged & marginalized people with vision loss. Oxigen CSR team in collaboration with Janak puri Dharmik & Samajik Mahasangh and Lions Eye Hospital, Delhi Eye successfully concluded a 11 Cataract Surgeries on August 20, 2018.. After screening 547 patients from last 4 camp in the month of July- aug , 21 were selected and 11 willing for surgery were operated for cataract at Lions Eye Hospital operation theatre counseling session was organized for the operated patients before they were Discharged . The doctors counseled the patients about precautions to be taken post operation.

Delhi The sequence of steps taken to screen, transport, and conduct the surgery are as follows:

 The patients who come to the camp site are registered
The patients are screened to determine their eyesight problem

4) Patients are then screened for high blood pressure and blood sugar

5) The patients who do not have any health complications and are deemed to be in need of cataract surgery are subjected to a final screening by the ophthalmologist

6) Patients are then transported to the hospital by bus provided by the OXIGEN & SAHYOG Foundation

7) The patients are admitted to the hospital and are operated

the same day.. During the surgical procedure, clouded lens is removed and a plastic intra-ocular lens is implanted

8) After staying for few hours, the patients are checked to ensure that there are no complications and are then transported back home.
