REPORT OF FREE EYE SCREENING CAMP AT ROHINI SEC 24 SLUM, DELHI ON MARCH 15TH, 2019

On 15th March 2019 Oxygen & Sahyog Foundation CSR team in Association with local Ngo at Shyam Colony Slum opp Rohini Sec 32 organized free eye screening camp for the slum Dwellers which includes identifying the errors pertaining to cataract, refractive errors, etc.

The main objective of the eye camp, on the one hand is, of course, to detect the issues pertaining to health in these slum areas, but also to create awareness among the underprivileged segment of the society, about the importance of regular health check-ups in order to detect the various diseases and disorders at an early stage, before it gets to the fatal stage and also to prevent them with better diet and precautions.



Oxygen & Sahyog CSR team made the best arrangements for the camp, wherein the expert doctor and trained staff successfully carry out the Eye camp. A total of 211 community members were screened at this camp, of which 129 were detected with refractive error, 16 with cataract and 135 with minor to major infections requiring Eye drops. The Refractive error patients were provided with spectacles and infected patients with Free Eye drops as per their prescriptions right at the camp venue and now we are in a process getting cataract surgeries for cataract

patients who are keen to get free surgery done.

We have to mention a big thank you to the entire team of Doctor and Ngo having helped with the setup and smooth and organized functioning of the camp and also the local community leader and his team's support for all the logistical support for the camp; without any of their support, this camp would not have been possible at all and we appreciate all the help and support!
