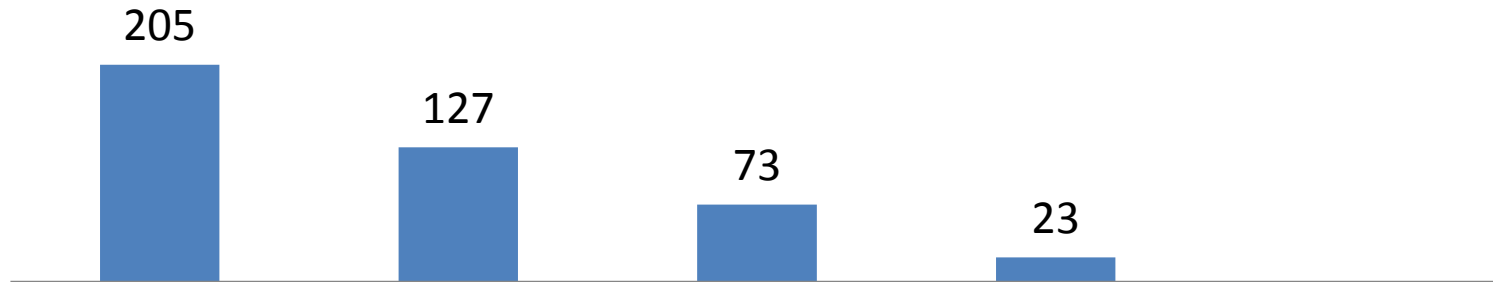


## Objectives Of The Eye Camp

- Provide Eye screening services to the community.
- Provide both preventive and curative treatment for common eye problem.
- Refer those who require specialized treatment as necessary.
- Provide information on prevention and management of preventable eye diseases.
- Encourage use of available nutritious food products in the area.

Sahyog Foundation and Oxigen organized free eye check-up camps for the villagers at Sohna road ward no. 18 Haryana. The objective of this camp was to create awareness about eye disorders and to detect refractive errors and eye ailments amongst villagers. The project was aimed to increase awareness and provide access to eye care services. Generating awareness about general eye care, cleanliness, hygiene and wellness also educate community members about eye infections, fading eyesight, conjunctivitis etc. At camp site we had more than 200 Participants attending our camps, where most of them were advised for further medical care or use of spectacles. 23 villagers were identified with cataract and were mobilized for cataract surgery next week. We also distribute 127 eye drops and 73 spectacles to the needy person . Since, villagers are not too hygienic and neither the people living in such areas are aware of preventing themselves from the various diseases they can suffer from due to in- hygiene. Therefore, we made our aim to educate them and provide them with knowledge to live more hygienically so that they too can lead a healthy life and prevent themselves and their families from any health issues.
