A Free Eye check-up camp was organized for construction workers by Greater Noida by Oxigen and Sahyog Foundation with the support from a local social organization working for migrants in Delhi- NCR .The camp was organized at the construction site Medicines were also given to the workers and their families. Many residents of the sub-city were also present at the camp. Volunteers from local Ngo assisted doctors in their work. Along with the Eye check up, their B.P, Sugar and height weight were also checked during the camp



During the camp Labourers were also made aware about health and hygiene, and the female members of their household about government facilities for pregnant women.

"Awareness is the key to staying healthy. We want people to understand the importance of good health. Organizing such camps gives us so much satisfaction. Residents from various societies were also enthusiastic about this initiative and supported it wholeheartedly," Added CSR Activist from Oxigen & Sahyog Foundation.

A total of 143 persons availed the services of the Eye Screening Camp. Out of these 57 patients were provided free spectacles and 72 with free Eye drops 3 patients were identified with cataract, would be treated/operated at Oxigen & Sahyog Foundation . All expenses incurred toward the cataract operations will be borne by Oxigen & Sahyog foundation only.
