Eye Care Camp

Oxigen & Sahyog foundation CSR Initiative- To reach out to the community and beyond; To make quality healthcare which is affordable and accessible to the bottom of Pyramid Oxigen & Sahyog foundation organized a free eye checkup and awareness camp for Manesar Village people at the CSP Point at Bank Hub, Gurgaon. A team of eye specialist and Para-medical staff carried out a comprehensive eye checkup on February 14, 2020. The main objective of this eye camp was to provide a complete eye checkup to the people and to see if there was any hope for their vision improvement.

Patients Care

Each participant went through the following levels of checkup:

Level-1: Registration: The details of the participants were undertaken.

Level-2: Vision Test: To check the level of visibility of the participant.



Level-3: Blood Pressure and Diabetes Test: Blood Pressure was the mandatory test for all the patients; diabetes was tested only if prescribed by the senior doctor.

Level-4: Refraction: It involved providing spectacles to the partially blind patients based on their vision level.

Level-5: Complicated cases were referred to the City Hospital.

Level-6: Patients detected with cataract were asked to deposit their documents at the earliest, for free cataract operation.

Community members actively participated in the Camp and Csp volunteered their services to manage the crowd and assisting the medical team. The camp ended by 4.00 p.m.

At this eye camp after 6 hours of hard work, 9 people were recommended for cataract problem and 162 people were treated for their poor vision. Some of the participants were prescribed medicines by the doctors and some were given available medicines on-the-spot. 58 Spectacles and more than 110eye drops were provided free of cost. The day of event was hectic yet satisfying

CSP & local villagers, Gurgaon, thanked the eye camp team, Para-medical staff and the management of Oxigen & Sahyog Foundation for rendering moral and selfless service to the Community.
