Eye camp no-19 /FY19-20

Oxygen & Sahyog foundation in association with Pravah Vocational training center, Gurugram, organized a Free Eye Screening Camp that offered a free eye-checkup to all the students (16- 45 years) coming to the center from the nearby villages of Gurugram for skill development as well as staff members of Pravah on August 9th, 2019 from 1.00pm- 5.00 pm in their Lecture Hall. Oxygen CSR team along with Eye camp team members, with the noble objective of diagnosing and preventing eye problem held a primary eye test to identify the students and staff members having defective eyes. Hundred and forty six students as well as sixteen staff members underwent the screening. During the free eye camps, 89 patients were given free



medicines and 47 free glasses. 8 were referred to Eye Hospital for free treatment. These patients will be treated free of cost in the hospital. After analyzing the presence of health care services in the areas from where these students are coming is very scarce due to the difficult accessibility of the area / availability of health resources. Keeping in view the most prevalent eye diseases, awareness session was also conducted by Oxygen CSR activist to educate the students & teachers regarding primary eye care and hygiene. DPS Pravah administration, and general population

appreciated the efforts of Oxygen & Sahyog Foundation .The Office bearers of Pravah extended their helping hand in organizing the camp smoothly.
