Eye camp no-9 /FY19-20

Free eye check- up camp was organized for the slum dwellers at Jeevan Park, Siraspur, Samaypur Badli at Oxygen's Ro point: Kapil store, On June 7, 2019 by Oxygen & Sahyog Foundation. Oxygen Eye team examined the eyes of 150 Slum dwellers Including Old people, adults & Children. 67 of whose eye sight was found poor were given spectacles on the spot, which put a smile on their faces. 98 people were provided with eye



drops for various eye conditions, 6 identified with Cataract were motivated to get surgery done in near future and 7 people were referred to hospital with various conditions for further treatment. Speaking on the occasion, Mr. Rajpal Duggal Oxygen CSR Head said, “Eyes play an important role in the functioning of human body along with other body organs. Life would be sheer darkness if vision is lost.” He further said, “On account of the lack of proper nutrition in the diet, the children are developing poor eyesight. This can be checked by creating general awareness



among the parents and the children.”

Apart from testing their eyes and getting them spectacles made for free, Team also educates them on how to take care of their eyes and vision.



Medical Camps left a significant impact in terms of providing better healthcare in our society, especially children and women in the Slum.

Sarita Devi a visitor to the camp shared with us” Since most of us are skilled labourers, we don’t find the need to get our vision rectified. But when someone told us that we can get ourselves spectacles made for free, I decided to get my eyes tested and came along with a neighbour who had the same problem “.

Oxygen Ro Kapil and slum dwellers were thankful to Oxygen team for all the efforts for organizing a camp and Management for camp support.

While the team was leaving Ro and few residents came forward and requested the foundation to conduct more such camps in their locality.
