Background- Vision is the greatest gift given by God to mankind. Through vision we can see the whole world and enjoy its beauty. But when people lose their vision, they lose the blessing of enjoying the world's beauty that God created. They become paralyzed, as they have to depend on others for all their essential daily needs. Bhaktawarpur village though being in Noida still is very remote area where qualified Doctors are hardly available so we can't even imagine the presence of Doctors and health services in the area because-

- It's very remote due to bad road condition
 - It's badly affected by extremism
 - No health professional want go in this area at any cost
- Rational for Eye Care Camp- Basic Eye Care services are not available in entire area around. Noida sec 30 is the nearest place where Eye care facilities are available which more than 11 K.M away from the area is. Eye care facilities if available in the big hospital are not in reach of Poor





villagers, especially all aged people of the area. Therefore a New Ngo Pure India who has opened a Vocational training center in this area in April 2019 had repeatedly requested Oxigen & Sahyog Foundation to organize an Eye Care Camp in their area. Conducting Eye Care Camp in the area was a herculean task but taken challenge to conduct a camp in spite of many hurdles and difficult conditions and has done it successfully on 26th July 2019.

Total No of Beneficiaries- Total no of 171 patients' Eyes screening was done, 84 patients requiring spectacles and 103 eye drops were handed over with the eye drops and spectacles at camp venue and total identified patients for surgery 11 were motivated to get their Cataract surgery which is free from Oxigen & Sahyog Foundation.

Eye Care Camp was organized at Pure India Vocational training center .Before conducting the Sahyog Foundation had taken permission from Sarpanch to conduct the camp. Intense IEC campaign (putting banners, spreading message through announcement, Handouts to VTC students & Door to Door) was done with Pure India support before the camp, that's why good amount of people turned up during the camp irrespective of heavy rainfall from 12 noon.
