Nearly 600 eye patients visited the camp sites. Of these, 35 patients were identified for cataract surgeries and 16 of them interested for surgery came to Hospital for the procedure on 18 th April 2019. 14 Successful free cataract surgeries were done after Free diagnosis and treatment facilities were made available to poor patients. The camp was followed by distribution of Free Medicines & Block Free Classes for the
