Mask Making at Livelihood Centers & Free Distribution'

Our Rural Livelihood centre located at Bhatta village Gautam Budh nagar, U.P, Which runs courses for skill development like stitching and tailoring

Students from these centres joint hands with Oxigen-Sahyog in partnership with Chorus Call, a movement to make masks at their Livelihood centres.

Understanding global need and essentiality of wearing mask during corona Pandemic.

Women & girls are stitching and distributing as many face masks as they can stitch at home and distribute around its area. They are also encouraging everyone who's able (even while staying at home) to lend their skills and resources to support local community by stitching and donating much needed protective masks as most of the men and women are now working in the fields during harvesting season and face mask is the only solution to stay safe after social distancing to combat the Corona virus.

Cutting & Tailoring instructor is also using her platform to inform her followers of the importance of staying at home, Social distancing (at field too) and giving other indications about what we should do in pandemic situation.

So far 6 of our students along with the instructor have stitched around 200 masks at their respective homes and have distributed them free of cost to the villagers who don't have.

They are also ensuring that the masks are well sanitized by properly washing them and hanging them in sunlight for drying before distributing them to the community.

Many more females showed their interest in joining the group, hoping they could spare out sometime after finishing their field and household work and join our group in completing a challenge of stitching 1000 masks in next 10 days.
