

PROJECT- MASKS MAKING BY SAHYOG LIVELIHOOD CENTERS DURING COVID 19

Taking a step to fight the COVID 19 virus, the Livelihood centre located at Budh Vihar slum in Rohini, Delhi which runs courses for skill development for stitching and tailoring came forward with the students making cloth masks.

So far about 650 masks made at the centre have been distributed in the community in Shiv Nagar free of cost as procuring mask at prohibitive cost from market was being the means of the underprivileged community.

Eight students under guidance of a trained teacher are all excited to take the challenge to make 500 masks per week and then to the next level of 1000 masks per week
