Eye Screening Camp

22nd December 2020 was special day for 140 People living in Yakubpur village Greater Noida as Sahyog Foundation in Association with NGO Pure India working in that village as part of the CSR towards society organized, a Free Eye checkup camp in the vicinity .The camp was organized at the Anganwadi Center with a aim to eliminate needless blindness to a certain extent in areas that need it most; The camp did prove true to charity that begins at home.



More than half of the people examined during the camp were found to be suffering from weak eyesight. A total of 140 people registered in this camp with 10 people identified as cataract patients. 108 beneficiaries were provided with free medicinal intervention to help them take

care of the various issues afflicting their eyes. A total of 58 beneficiaries were provided with near-vision spectacles and distance-vision spectacles.

Speaking on this occasion the doctors advised all students and Women to look after personal hygiene and care, both for themselves and their family members. CSR team also educated the Young Children and Women on ways and benefits of cleanliness along with healthy eating habits for better health and immune system.
