With the rapid increase of the COVID 19 positive cases in the capital, the residents especially the people living in the J J clusters are in dilemma.

At this pandemic time Sahyog Foundation came forward provided full ground support to Group of Friends Welfare Trust in Free ration Distribution to the Daily Wagers without Income on 28th May 2020.

Kathputli colony is a colony of street performers in Shadipur Depot area of Delhi . Government of Delhi initiated a Redevelopment Project of colony, Inhabitants were shifted to transit camps built at Anand Parbat and they are now waiting for flats now in transit camp. The transit camp provide temporary accommodation to 3000families with more than 12000 members. Most of the inhabitants are street acrobats, Puppeteers, Magicians, and Dhowlwala etc

GoFWT arranged Dry Ration packets for hundred families amongst most needy. The ration Kit included 5kg Atta, 2 Kg Rice, 1kg Daal, 1kg Sugar, 1kg salt, 250 gm tealeaves ,2 soaps and 5 packets of Biscuits .Everyone appreciated the efforts and were happy to receive the ration Sahyog foundation provided ground support by doing s detailed site review prior to distribution date, identified location and managed the distribution.
