NEW DELHI: Eye problems, like many other health issues, often go untreated in India. Be it poverty, difficulty to access healthcare, negligence towards the elders, due to absence of escorting and poor awareness in the community many of the patients were blind for the last few years. Surgical eye camps in remote areas are necessary for the coming years and which is the major solution to eliminate avoidable blindness in this region.

Patients were grateful to Oxigen & Sahyog Foundation for conducting such surgeries free of cost. They are now able to feel the world once again through their improved visions. Meals and medicines were provided along with a full day's rest at hospital after the surgery. The patients are also provided with post-operative medication, colored glasses and two follow up visits. Proud to Share that Patients were very happy with surgery & the arrangements at hospital.

Oxigen & Sahyog foundation has brought a new ray of hope for the hopeless and helpless people. The patients being operated at hospital acknowledge that with the help & blessings of volunteers rendering selfless services to them more than their own kin they will be able to restore their vision back.
