During this COVID 19 time One of the initiatives at ACT Grants is to resolve the PPE challenges in the country, for which ACT Grants has partnered with Arvind Mills to ramp up the production of N95 masks.

Over the next 6-12 months, ACT Grants + Arvind Mills partnership will provide ~9 million N95 masks at concessional rates to the following target groups:

- •ASHAs, AWWs
- Sanitation workers
- •Municipal workers
- Mortuary workers
- •Healthcare workers in charitable hospitals

Oxigen & Sahyog Foundation took this project as a facilitation partners who will identify (and verify) demand and facilitate last mile delivery to the said beneficiaries in Tier 1 and 2 cities. In the last two months we have reached more than 1000 CARONA worriers in our working communities (ANM, Anganwadi workers, NGO Health staff) along with Police on duty and had distributed these mask free of cost to them. Going ahead we will be continuing this project for couple of months
