Delhi, April 2021

NEW DELHI: Eye problems, like many other health issues, often go untreated in India. Be it poverty, difficulty to access healthcare, negligence towards the elders, due to absence of escorting and poor awareness in the community many of the patients were blind for the last few years. Surgical eye camps in remote areas are necessary for the coming years and which is the major solution to eliminate avoidable blindness in this region.

Meanwhile cataract (clouding in the lens of the eye), can all too often lead to blindness if untreated. The impact on lives is devastating; especially in a country where many people face a daily struggle to survive. Eye surgery can have a huge impact on the lives of patients, improving their ability to live a dignified and healthy life. Oxigen & Sahyog foundation has successfully completed two more Cataract surgery camp, aimed at giving Marginalized population back their sight. On April 2 & 5 ,2021 Oxigen CSR with Eye Mantra hospital reached the hospital early morning with 5 and 4 cataract identified patients on respective days and with the aim to helped them getting their vision back were registered at hospital registration counter. After some time they all were dilated and post examination few prerequisite tests required for cataract surgery were administered. Once all the test was assessed team at hospital assigned each patient with a surgery date. We would like to express our cordial thanks to Eye mantra Hospital, Delhi and Its Doctors and Paramedical staff, for their appreciable support. Patients are grateful to Oxigen & Sahyog Foundation for conducting such surgeries free of cost. Patients after the surgery feel the world once again through their improved visions. Meals and medicines were provided along with a full day's rest at hospital after the surgery.
